## 2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION SUMMARY

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN – CAUTION - May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. May cause eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid contact with open cuts or sores. Avoid breathing vapors. Use with adequate ventilation. Eye protection and gloves are suggested when handling undiluted product. This microbial-based catalyst solution of Urea Ammonium Nitrate and non-plant food ingredients (see product label for specific ingredients). ### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES
