PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

AD-WET 90 is intended for use with pesticides that are labeled for agricultural and non-agricultural uses.

AD-WET 90 cannot be used for aquatic applications. Some pesticide labels recommend a higher or lower surfactant use rate for optimum efficacy. Follow the pesticide label directions when this occurs.

DOSAGE PER 100 GALLONS OF SPRAY MIX:

Herbicides	1 to 3 pints
Defoliant and Desiccants.....	1 to 2 pints
Wettable Powders	1 to 2 pints
Insecticides	3 to 8 ounces
Fungicides.....	3 to 8 ounces
Acaricides.....	3 to 8 ounces

For use with Monsanto glyphosate herbicides refer to the herbicide label for recommended surfactant rates. Do not add this product at a rate which exceeds 5% of the finished spray volume. For wettable powders, water soluble materials and emulsifiable products add AD-WET 90 in water after a good mixture is formed.

AD-WET 90 can be used with most insecticides, fungicides, herbicides, defoliant and desiccants to improve the performance of the active spray ingredients by giving more uniform distribution and better wetting of the plant surface.

AD-WET 90 is a broad-spectrum adjuvant specifically designed for optimum activity enhancement when used with a wide range of pesticides and solvents such as water, aromatics, alcohol and aliphatics.
