GENERAL INFORMATION

AQUATE[™] PRO is a multi-functional soil surfactant. When applied to turfgrass, AQUATE PRO improves water infiltration and prolongs the soils ability to retain moisture over an extended period of time.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Always follow the AQUATE PRO label recommendations when using this product, unless directed otherwise by the label of a tank mix partner product. The general recommended use rate is 3-6 fluid ounces per 1,000 square feet. Timing and volume of irrigation following application should be dictated by the function of tank mix partners and or the intended positioning of the surfactant within the soil profile. Soil type and environmental conditions may affect the application rate. (See also SOIL TYPE AND CONDITIONS.)

Spray Applications:

Apply AQUATE PRO at a rate of 3 fluid ounces per 1,000 square feet every two weeks or 6 fluid ounces per 1,000 square feet monthly. A minimum of 40 gallons per acre of water carrier is recommended. Rates and timing may vary based on soil conditions.

Irrigation Injection Applications:

Inject AQUATE PRO at a rate of 2 pints per acre and repeat as needed based on the desired soil water conditions.

SOIL TYPE AND CONDITIONS

AQUATE PRO may be applied across a broad range of soil types. The specific combination of surfactants in AQUATE PRO improves water penetration into the soil and increases the length of time in which the water is retained in the soil.

COMPATIBILITY AND MIXING

When mixing AQUATE PRO with plant nutrients or other products, it is recommended to perform a jar test to confirm compatibility. Agitation is recommended in fertigation tanks to ensure uniform mixing and injection of nutrients and AQUATE PRO.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning equipment.
