Personal Protective Equipment: Wear chemical splash eyewear, face shield and acid impermeable gloves, long-sleeve shirt and pants, rubber apron and shoes and socks.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CHAOS is an NPE free, low foaming, nonionic surfactant formulated to spread throughout the target surface and deliver a more uniform distribution of the active ingredient.

NPE free CHAOS meets all pesticide manufacturers' requirements for a nonionic surfactant.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Not for aquatic use in the state of Washington.

Follow the recommendations of the most restrictive active ingredient label.

Tank mixtures should only be applied within the label recommendations of every product in the tank mixture.

Use only if a nonionic surfactant and spreader-activator are allowed or not excluded on the label.

Do not pre-mix with pesticides, nutrients or other adjuvants before mixing with water. If the user does not have experience with the mixture being applied, perform a jar test using the order and amounts in the mixture and perform a phytotoxicity test to ensure crop safety.

Order of addition

In general, follow the W-A-L-E-S plan when adding herbicides to a tank mix.

1. Wettable Powders (WP) then Flowables (F, DF)
2. Agitate then add adjuvants such as anti-foaming compounds, buffers
3. Liquid and Soluble products
4. Emulsifiable concentrates (EC)
5. Surfactants or other adjuvants

Add CHAOS as the last ingredient to the tank mix.

Prior to mixing you should fill your spray tank with half of the carrier you intend to use, usually water. Then start the sprayer and check to make sure that all valves and gauges work and that you have proper tank agitation.

Insecticides, fungicides, miticides		4 to 8 ounces
Herbicides, defoliants, desiccants		8 to 64 ounces

The most effective rate in average field conditions is 1 quart per acre.

Follow the directions on the aquatic herbicide label for aquatic use rate.

The higher rate may be required for best active ingredient performance where water quality is unknown or with mature, weather hardened species.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Keep container tightly closed. Keep only in original container. Store in a cool well-ventilated place. Keep in original container tightly closed. Do not reuse empty container. Do not store with food, feed, or other material to be used or consumed by humans or animals. Do not contaminate water supplies. For optimal storage, store between 40° and 90° F.

Disposal: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Dispose of contents/container at an approved waste disposal facility. Triple rinse (or equivalent) adding rinse water to spray tank. Offer container for recycling or dispose of container in sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by appropriate authorities. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal. The Agricultural Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates the national recycling program.
