GENERAL INFORMATION

CYNDER® is a proprietary mix of water conditioning agents and surfactants. It is designed for use with herbicide products registered for agriculture, forestry, turf and ornamental, industrial sites, noncropland and rights-of-way.

CYNDER is effective with a broad range of herbicides, especially those based on glyphosate. It improves wetting and deposition of the spray mixture resulting in a more uniform spray deposit, which can increase the degree and rate that the herbicide is absorbed into the plant.

NOT FOR AQUATIC USE.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CYNDER may be applied by ground, aerial and any other type of spray equipment recommended by the manufacturer's pesticide label.

USE RATES

Use 1-4 quarts of CYNDER per 100 gals of spray mix for water conditioning and herbicide activation. Always follow the adjuvant use recommendations as shown on the pesticide label.

For pesticides that permit use of an adjuvant at a higher rate, follow instructions on that pesticide label. However, do not add this product at a rate which exceeds 5% of the finished spray volume, except when used as a diluent in dormant, basal, site preparation or other similar applications, per label instructions. Use caution at the higher use rates. When applying to a sensitive crop, first treat a small area to determine if there are any adverse effects to the crop.

The addition of an adjuvant to some herbicides or tank mixes may cause phytotoxicity to susceptible crops. Do not use CYNDER with a herbicide if an adjuvant is prohibited by the manufacturer.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
