GENERAL INFORMATION

ENACT is a water conditioning adjuvant that can be used as an ammonium sulfate replacement. ENACT contains water conditioning agents that will aid in controlling hard water antagonism. ENACT contains ammoniacal nitrogen that improves pesticide uptake. ENACT contains no surfactant. Additional adjuvants may be required to maximize pesticide performance. ENACT has excellent plant safety. ENACT can increase the activity of some pesticides.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For Use With Products Registered For: Agricultural, Forestry, Industrial, Municipal, Ornamental, Rights-of-Way, Turf and Non-Cropland.

When adding additional adjuvants to the tank mix, some combinations may exhibit phytotoxic effects to the foliage or crop. Users must have experience with the combinations or follow the labeling requirements for all products and the adjuvant restrictions. Refer to and follow the pesticide label directions regarding adjuvants and loading procedures.

USE RATES

ENACT should be used at 2-4 pints/100 gallons. Use ENACT at 2 pints/100 gallons if spray water has ≤300 ppm hardness. Use ENACT at 4 pints/100 gallons if spray water has > 300 ppm hardness.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT - Add ENACT to the spray tank first before adding any other tank mix product, unless the tank mix pesticide(s) or additives direct otherwise.

Mixing Order

1. Fill tank 1/2 full of water and begin agitation.
2. Add the required amount of ENACT while agitating.
3. Continue filling spray tank with water and add the tank mix components as directed on the pesticide label(s).

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Store product in original container. Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not reuse container. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Keep packaging closed, securely fastened and upright. Product may suspend in layers if stored below 0°F.

Triple rinse (or equivalent) prior to disposal. Add rinsate to spray tank. Offer container for recycling or dispose of in accordance with all applicable regulations. If burned, stay out of smoke.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED:

- Call a doctor or poison control center immediately.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
