ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS

Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment wash waters.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

FIRST AID

If Swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have the person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Product Benefit: Drift reduction agent, deposition aid, canopy penetrating agent.

FieldGrip DRA is a high-concentrate emulsifiable deposition aid and drift management adjuvant. **FieldGrip DRA** can increase deposition of spray deposits and improve spray droplet retention on the leaf or target surface. When used according to the label **FieldGrip DRA** minimizes formation of spray fines that can move off-target or evaporate. **FieldGrip DRA** is suitable for use with most agrochemicals and spray nozzle types when used at recommended rates. **FieldGrip DRA** requires no special handling or mixing procedures. **FieldGrip DRA** is an APE-free formula designed for use with herbicides, fungicides, and insecticides. APE (alkyl phenyl ethoxylate) has been linked to Arrested Ear Syndrome in corn.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Prior to use, read all directions on this label and on the label of the pesticide to be applied.

Do not use where the pesticide label prohibits the use of an adjuvant. If the label neither recommends nor prohibits an adjuvant, the applicator must have prior experience with the adjuvant/pesticide mix under local conditions.

The addition of adjuvants to some pesticides, fertilizers and their tank mixes may cause phytotoxicity. Before using **FieldGrip DRA**, the applicator or crop advisor must have experience with the pesticide combination, including **FieldGrip DRA**, or must have conducted a phytotoxicity test.

For General Use: 1 quart per 100 gallons of spray (0.25% v/v). Do not use **FieldGrip DRA** at a rate in excess of 1% v/v. These rates are sufficient for most uses. Some pesticide labels may require higher or lower adjuvant rates. Read and follow the pesticide label in such cases.

MIXING

Always start with spray equipment that has been thoroughly cleaned. Refer to the specific mixing instructions listed on the respective pesticide label(s) prior to mixing. In the absence of specific mixing instructions, fill the spray tank with at least 50% of the final carrier volume. While the carrier is agitating, add tank mix ingredients in the following order:

1. Antifoam and / or compatibility agent
2. Dry formulations (WP, DF, WDG, SG, SP) and ammonium sulfate
3. Flowable formulations (F & FL), liquid concentrates or suspensions (LC, ME, SC, CS)
4. Emulsifiable concentrates (E or EC)
5. Soluble liquids (S or SL)
6. **FieldGrip DRA**, water conditioners and other adjuvants
7. Finish filling and continue agitation

Do not mix **FieldGrip DRA** with other undiluted adjuvants in an induction tank or container. Once diluted, **FieldGrip DRA** is compatible with most tank mix partners.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place, in original container only. Keep containers tightly sealed when not in use. Protect product from freezing. If product freezes, warm to room temperature before use.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal if allowed by law.
