**GENERAL INFORMATION**

FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 is a high purity blend of copper, manganese and zinc, formulated for immediate plant uptake and utilization. FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 contains a proprietary blend of enzymatically hydrolyzed proteins and organic acids and fulvic acids. Its use is suggested as a supplement to a regular, balanced fertilizer program to enhance yields and improve quality.

Application of FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 is a means of obtaining a quick response to needed elements. Foliar applications of FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 may be particularly beneficial during periods of peak nutrient demand, for crops grown on soils having poor nutrient availability or to crops suffering from a weakened root system. Avoid foliar nutrient applications to crops during periods of moisture, salinity or heat stress. Applications of foliar nutrients to sensitive crops such as leafy vegetables or soft-skinned fruit during periods of excessive temperatures may cause cosmetic injury. FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 should be used as part of a comprehensive Total Nutrition System for optimizing plant growth, development, yield and quality.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 may be applied as a foliar spray by air or by ground. Maintain agitation to provide uniform distribution within the spray tank. Thorough and even spray coverage is essential for maximum nutrient uptake and crop safety. Always include a high quality wetting agent, such as R-11 or SYL-COAT, at recommended rates. Optimum rate of application will vary based on a variety of factors including degree of need or deficiency, growth stage, yield potential, environmental conditions, existing soil fertility levels, etc.

MIXING DIRECTIONS: Be sure tank is thoroughly cleaned. Fill 1/2 full of clean water, add FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 and continue filling tank with water while agitating.

APPLICATIONS: FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 can be applied by ground and aerial spray equipment, drip and overhead sprinklers and with applications of other fertilizers and micronutrients.

DILUTION AND SPRAY VOLUMES: Use enough water for uniform application and to prevent possible crop injury from concentrated droplets.

WARNING: FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 contains zinc which can damage sensitive plant tissues when applied at concentrated volumes and pH below 5.0. Consult with a qualified representative before using.

FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 is an effective form of zinc, manganese and copper that is rapidly taken up by plant foliage. Although it is recommended to water run FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 whenever possible, foliar applications are also effective. However, it is very important to utilize small doses over multiple applications. It is highly recommended to perform proper plant and tissue analysis to determine plant needs. Have a qualified crop consultant make final recommendations.

CAUTION: Foliar applications containing zinc can be phytotoxic, especially to sensitive growth points. Use extreme caution when applying FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 in foliar sprays with a final application pH of 5.5 or less. Apply foliar rate with at least 10-20 gallons of water per acre.

DECIDUOUS FRUIT (Apples, Pears, Cherries, Prunes, Apricots, Peaches, Plums and Nectarines): Use 1-2 quarts/acre water run as required, 1-2 pints/acre foliar in a minimum of 100 gallons/acre water. Apply at pre-bloom or post-harvest. Do not apply under poor drying conditions; do not spray at temperatures above 84°F; do not aerial apply; and use maximum rates of water.

ALFALFA, CLOVER, MINT: Foliar apply 16-32 ounces/acre. Apply at 6-8 inches tall, repeat as needed.

BEANS (Dry, Succulent and Limas): Foliar apply 16-32 ounces/acre. Apply when leaves are large enough to absorb foliar nutrient or from bud stage to early bloom.

CORN (Field and Sweet): Foliar apply 16-32 ounces/acre at 8-12 inches tall.

GRAPES: Foliar apply 16-32 ounces/acre at first leaves to bloom stage.

HOPS: Foliar apply 16-32 ounces/acre, as needed, from the time sufficient foliage is present.

LEGUMES (Peas, Lentils and Garbanzos): Foliar apply 16-32 ounces/acre. Apply when leaves are large enough to absorb foliar nutrient or from bud stage to mid bloom.

POTATOES: Foliar apply 16-32 ounces/acre at 1st stage of tuber development. Repeat as required.

SMALL GRAINS: Foliar apply 1-2 quarts/acre from 4th-6th leaf stage to prior to early boot stage.

SUGAR BEETS: Foliar apply 16-32 ounces/acre from 6th-8th leaf stage. Repeat every 10-14 days if required.

SOIL APPLICATIONS: Use 1-2 quarts per acre water run, banded or side-dressed. Not recommended for direct seed placement.

**COMPATIBILITY**

FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 is compatible with many co-applied nutrient sources as well as plant protection products. Always jar test new combinations for compatibility prior to field mixing. FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 can be blended with calcium solutions. FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 is not compatible with most phosphate fertilizers, however, BIOLATOR may be used for increased compatibility. FOLI-GRO MICRO 363 is compatible with pH balanced phosphate sources such as MORA-LEAF P&K.
