FS Intention DVA is a unique activator adjuvant premix specifically designed for use with dicamba containing tank mixes. FS Intention DVA utilizes a unique activator surfactant system with a plant-based, shear-resistant, polymer that improves performance on a wider range of weed species by increasing spray droplet deposition, adhesion, retention and uptake. FS Intention DVA is recognized as a qualified and approved DRA for dicamba-based herbicide tank mixes. Check manufacturer labels and websites for confirmation.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

The addition of adjuvants to some pesticides and/or fertilizers and their tank mixes may cause phytotoxicity to the foliage and/or fruit of desirable crops. USE RATES

1.25% v/v (5 quarts per 100 gallons of spray solution) or a minimum of 24 ounces per acre for Engenia®, Tavium®, or XtendiMax $^{\otimes}$.

MIXING

In the absence of specific mixing instructions found on the pesticide label or website, fill the spray tank with at least 50% of the desired finished carrier volume and while the carrier is agitating, add approved tank mix ingredients in the following order:

- 1. Compatibility agent and/or antifoam if needed
- 2. Dry formulations (WP, DF, WDG, SP)
- 3. Dry soluble and suspension fertilizers / micronutrients
- 4. FS Intention DVA
- 5. Flowable formulations (F & FL)
- Liquid concentrates, suspension concentrates, microencapsulated and capsule suspension (LC, SC, ME, CS)
- 7. Emulsifiable concentrates (E, EL or EC)
- 8. Solutions and soluble liquids (S or SL)
- 9. Liquid micronutrients and fertilizers
- 10. Other approved adjuvants (COC, HSOC, MSO, NIS)
- 11. Finish filling to desired volume and continue agitation
