GENERAL INFORMATION

HASTEN-EA® may be used with pesticides applied to commercially grown crops, vegetation management, aquatic environments, rangelands, and turf and ornamentals. HASTEN-EA may be applied in concentrate and dilute applications, by air or ground (including backpack), and may be used in chemigation applications.

Read label of pesticide carefully. Keep container tightly closed and DO NOT allow water to be introduced to contents of this container.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Shake well before use. To ensure thorough mixing, it is suggested that you recirculate mini tanks and bulk tanks or shake containers before using.

Fill spray tank one-half full of water. Add the required amount of pesticide while agitating. Add remainder of the water. Add the recommended amount of HASTEN-EA last and continue agitation until completion of spraying.

When applying at the higher rates, use caution.

When applying to a sensitive crop, and before making a full-scale treatment, begin by treating a small area to determine if there may be adverse effects on the crop or plants.

USE RATES

ACARICIDES: Use 1/2-2 pints per 100 gallons of spray mix or use ¼ - 1 pint per acre in concentrate sprays of 50 gallons or less.

AQUATICS: HASTEN-EA may be used as an additive with aquatically labeled pesticides. The use rate for HASTEN-EA should follow the recommended adjuvant rate that is specified on the pesticide label.

DEFOLIANTS: 1/2-2 pints per acre of HASTEN-EA in combination with defoliant.

DESSICANTS: Use 1-2 gallons per acre of HASTEN-EA with desiccants.

FUNGICIDES and INSECTICIDES: Use 1/2-2 pints per 100 gallons of spray mix or use ¼ - 1 pint per acre in concentrate sprays of 50 gallons or less.

HERBICIDES: Use 1-4 pints of HASTEN-EA per acre, the addition of a nitrogen fertilizer such as 28%-32% nitrogen solution or ammonium sulfate may be required to improve control under extreme environmental conditions or to satisfy certain label requirements.

When mixing with 2 or more pesticides, do not exceed 1 pint HASTEN-EA per 100 gallons of spray mixture when applied in cover sprays to sensitive crops such as leafy vegetables, soft-skinned fruits, strawberries, nut crops in bloom, grapes, or ornamental crops.

For pesticides that permit use of an adjuvant at a higher rate, follow instructions on that pesticide label. However, do not add this product at a rate which exceeds 5% of the finished spray volume.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PRODUCT STORAGE: Store in original container only and keep container tightly sealed. Do not allow water to be introduced to the contents of this container. Store in closed storage areas. Do not store near heat or open flame.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: Dispose of contents in accordance with local, regional and national regulations. To avoid waste, use all material in this container by application according to label directions. If wastes cannot be avoided, offer remaining product to a waste disposal facility or pesticide disposal program.

CONTAINER HANDLING: Triple rinse (or equivalent), then offer for recycling or reconditioning. Recycling cleaned containers is the best option of container disposal.
