FIRST AID

CALL A POISON CONTROL CENTER OR DOCTOR IF YOU FEEL UNWELL

If in eyes: Hold eyes open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes then continue rinsing eyes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Lift™ is a surfactant and buffering system that enhances activity of agrochemicals that benefit from spray tank pH levels in a basic range (>7.0). Lift™ is suitable for use with agrochemicals that recommend combinations of surfactants and nitrogen fertilizer as a spray tank additive and generally eliminates the need for additional nitrogen based fertilizers (UAN, 10-34-0 or AMS). Lift™ is also engineered to be compatible with tank mixtures containing MSO adjuvants like Exuro™. Lift™ can improve solubility of many small grain herbicides, or other herbicides including sulfonyleureas or imidazolinones. Do not use this product with pesticide formulations containing sulfuric acid (i.e.ASSERT) or in tank-mixtures containing highly acidic spray adjuvants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Prior to use read all directions on this label and on the label of the product used. The product label for specific usages and restrictions have precedence over directions for uses referred to on this label.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

SHAKE WELL OR RECIRCULATE BEFORE USE

1. Fill sprayer 1/3 to 1/2 full of water
2. Add dry flowables or dispersible granules
3. Add emulsifiable concentrates
4. Add additional adjuvants as required
5. Add Lift™ to the agitating spray tank

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep containers tightly closed. Store in original container. Do not allow water or other chemicals to be introduced into contents of container.
