PondMaster® Watercolors™ Lake & Pond Dye Shimmer Blue is a concentrated blend of environmentally friendly colorants that impart a shimmering blue to aquamarine color to lakes and ponds while reducing sunlight penetration and maximizing surface reflectivity. Treated water is non-toxic to horses, cattle, pets, aquatic plants, turfgrass, waterfowl, mammals, reptiles, fish or other aquatic species. Irrigation, swimming and other recreational activities are approved following the use of this product.

GETTING STARTED

WHERE TO USE:

For application to ponds, lakes, fisheries and ornamental bodies of water.

IMPORTANT: Do not apply this product to water intended for direct human consumption. Do not use this product for streams, rivers or other bodies of water which are not under the control of the user. Only use this product in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.

HOW TO USE:

For best results, pour the correct dosage of concentrate directly into the water at several different locations to improve the dispersion of the dye. Once the initial treatment has completely dispersed, you may add more concentrate to increase the color intensity if desired.

HOW MUCH TO USE:

Apply directly to water at a rate of 32 fl. oz. of concentrate per 1 acre foot of water. If you do not know the surface acres of the body of water to be treated, use the following formula to determine your number of "acre-feet" volume:

Number of Acre-Feet =

43,560 sq. ft.

FIRST AID
