DIRECTIONS FOR USE: CAUTION this fertilizer contains Zinc and should only be used when recommended. It may prove harmful if not used correctly. This product is to be used where zinc deficiencies have been identified by soil/tissue analysis. For use in berry crops, tree fruits, and grapes:

SOIL APPLICATIONS: Apply 500ml – 2L / hectare, (7-28fl oz/Acr) Do not exceed 6L/Ha (2.6 Qt / Acre) per season.

FOLIAR APPLICATIONS: Apply 1 - 4.8L in 450L water / Ha, (14-67.2fl oz/Acr in a minimum of 50Ga water per acre) Repeat applications as needed. Seek the advice of a certified crop consultant for application rates and timings for desired crops. Pro Zinc should be well mixed with water before application. Conduct a jar test for tank mixing with other products.

FIRST AID: If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Wash clothing before reuse. If in eyes: Flush with running water for at least 15 minutes while holding eyelids open. Get medical attention. Ingestion: Drink 1-2 glasses of water and induce vomiting.
