GENERAL INFORMATION

R-900® is a high quality, LOW-FOAMING, NONIONIC surfactant formulated specifically to improve the performance of some herbicides and insecticides. In addition to improving penetration into leaf surfaces, R-900 promotes quick wetting and uniform coverage of the spray deposit on the plant surface. R-900 is effective with both contact and systemic pesticides such as Arsenal®, Reglone®, Gramoxone®, Telar®, Pramitol®, Roundup®, Oust®, Transline®, and Tordon®.

NOT FOR AQUATIC USE.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

R-900 is to be used as a plant tissue penetrant. Rates of R-900 may vary with the conditions of application, water quality and plant surfaces. Use just enough to form a uniform film. Always add R-900 as the last ingredient to the spray tank with the agitator running. **Note:** Observe all precautions and limitations on the labeling of products used in a particular tank mix. Follow the use instructions and rates on the pesticide labels.

Herbicides: Unless otherwise directed by the manufacturer of the herbicides use 1/2 to 2 pints (8 oz. to 32 oz.) of R-900 per 100 gallons of spray solution for post-emergence products such as 2,4-D Amine, Basagran®, and Gramoxone.

Insecticides: R-900 may be used to enhance the effectiveness of certain insecticides. Use 1/4 to 1 pint (4 oz. to 16 oz.) per 100 gallons of spray solution, in field crops only. Do not use on stone or pome fruits or on grape vines. Always consult your Wilbur-Ellis field person or salesperson before using.

Defoliants & Desiccants: Use 1 to 2 quarts (32 oz. to 64 oz.) per 100 gallons of spray solution. R-900 should be used where difficult wetting and increased penetration of plant foliage is desired.

Reduced Tillage Systems and Chemical Fallow: Use 1/2 to 1% of the total spray volume.

Vegetation Control (Top Absorption): Use 1% of the total spray volume.

R-900 is not for use in greenhouses or on ornamental nursery stock.

DO NOT ADD THIS PRODUCT AT A RATE WHICH EXCEEDS 5% OF THE FINISHED SPRAY VOLUME.

USE RESTRICTIONS

Not for aquatic use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
