GENERAL INFORMATION

RNA HP ZINC is designed for foliar applications to prevent or correct zinc deficiencies that may limit growth and yields. This proprietary water soluble formulation is readily available to the plant because of the natural complexing properties of soy protein hydrolysate. It is intended for foliar applications and is non-toxic to plants when applied as directed. This product can be included in a regular spray program on all field, root, vegetable, fruit and vine crops, and turf and ornamentals.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. KEEP FROM FREEZING.

Dilute one part **RNA HP ZINC** with 20 or more parts water. Apply with an adequate amount of water that will provide complete coverage. Use of a nonionic wetting agent may improve spray coverage of certain hard-to-wet plants. **Do not apply undiluted.**

The rate of application will depend on the crop, stage of growth, and severity of deficiency. The maximum recommended rates are for mature, full-sized plants. Reduce the rates proportionately when spraying smaller plants.

TREE FRUIT: Apply 8-80 fluid ounces per acre after the beginning of active growth. Repeat at 2 to 4-week intervals as needed throughout the growing season. On deciduous trees, 2-80 fluid ounces may be applied in the oil sprays at the delayed dormant stage. Post-harvest application of 2-80 fluid ounces may be made while active, green leaves remain on the trees.

GRAPES AND BERRIES: Apply 2-32 fluid ounces per acre after active growth begins. Repeat weekly as needed throughout the vegetative growth period.

TREE NUTS: Apply 8-80 fluid ounces per acre after the beginning of active growth. Repeat at 2 to 4-week intervals as needed throughout the growing season.

FIELD AND VEGETABLE CROPS: Apply 2-24 fluid ounces per acre during periods of rapid growth or nutritional stress. Repeat as needed throughout the growing season.

ORNAMENTAL TREES, SHRUBS, AND FLOWERING PLANTS: Apply 32 fluid ounces in 10 or more gallons of water and spray to complete coverage.

COMPATIBILITY

Consult with your local ag representative on compatibility with other spray materials. Always jar test new combinations for compatibility prior to field mixing.
