General Information

Stoller's Root Power is designed to increase the root growth of plants when it is applied directly to the rooting area through irrigation or by drenching along side of the plants. Stoller's Root Power contains zinc and boron which are micronutrients that affect a plant's natural hormones responsible for cell division and cell elongation. The root growth will greatly affect the growth habits of the plant. It will also help maintain nutrient health in an environment where insects, disease and nematodes may be a problem.

WARNING

Keep Out Of Reach Of Children

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. May cause irritation of nose, throat, and/or skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. First Aid: If swallowed, induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention. Storage Instructions

Store product three pails high per pallet. Do not stack pallets. Freezing temperature is less than 15°F. Caution: Do not apply any other ingredients in the Root Power application unless compatibility is known.

Directions for Use

Apply 1 pint of Root Power per acre through drip irrigation per week. Alternatively, apply 2 ounces per acre of Root Power through any other manner of irrigation or soil drench in the rooting area of the plants.

This application of 1 pint per acre per week should begin after plant is transplanted or at approximately the 2 to 3 leaf stage on plants which are started by planting seeds.

Stoller's Root Power may be diluted in any amount of water at the time of application. Application should continue until harvest is completed. At that time, the applications may be discontinued.

Root Power is recommended on but not limited to the following crops: Alfalfa, Almonds, Avocados, Apples, Barley, All beans, Broccoli, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Carrots, Celery, Citrus, Corn, Cotton, Grapes, Lawns, Lettuce, Milo, Melons, Nectarines, Tea, Rice, Pears, Peaches, Pecans, Peppers, Plums, Prunes, Potatoes, Peanuts, Sorghum, Soybeans, Sugar beets, Sweet Corn, Sugar cane, Strawberries, Tomatoes, Turf, Turnips, Walnuts, Watermelons, Wheat and most other crops.

Caution

This product contains boron and should be used only according to label directions as some crops can be injured by boron.

Mixing Instructions

Do not mix with fertilizers containing phosphorus or sulfur. Many pesticides may be mixed and applied with any solution containing ROOT POWER. Mixing sequence: 1. Water, 2. ROOT POWER, 3. Pesticide or other fertilizer. Always conduct a "jar test" utilizing all products to be mixed in proper proportion in order to establish compatibility.

Precautionary Statement
