Soaker® Plus A is a proprietary blend of biodegradable nonionic polyol surfactants designed to function as a spray adjuvant/wetting agent. Soaker® Plus A is safe for applications to new or existing turf and improves the uniform movement of water, pesticides, and fertilizers into soils. Soaker® Plus A is not harmful to animals when used as recommended.

Soaker® Plus A can be safely applied in the spring and summer, even when environmental factors may impact turf quality. It can be applied prior to the activation of irrigation systems.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GOLF COURSES (Greens, Tees, and Fairways) AND ATHLETIC FIELDS

For maintenance: Apply 4-8 ounces of Soaker® Plus A per 1,000 square feet in 1 gallon of water. Reapply monthly, starting one month before the onset of stress conditions. Irrigate before next mowing, or leave baskets off to ensure that Soaker® Plus A makes contact with soil. (Soaker® Plus A does not need to be watered in immediately after application.)

Injection Rates: Inject Soaker® Plus A directly into irrigation system at 1-3 gallons per acre in conjunction with or shortly after the application of pesticides and/or fertilizers.

LAWNS - GENERAL TURF

For maintenance: Apply 4-8 ounces of Soaker® Plus A per 1,000 square feet in 1 gallon of water in conjunction with or shortly after the application of pesticides and/or fertilizers. Repeat at 4-8 ounces of Soaker® Plus A per 1,000 square feet in 1 gallon of water on a weekly basis with irrigation water, pesticides, and/or fertilizers. SEEDING

Soaker® Plus A may enhance the application of pesticides and/or fertilizers applied during seeding. Apply Soaker® Plus A at 2 ounces per 1,000 square feet in 2 gallons of water to the surface of areas to be seeded.

Apply 4-8 ounces of Soaker® Plus A per 1,000 square feet in 2 gallons of water with pesticides and/or fertilizers after laying the sod.

ORNAMENTAL RATES:

Apply in conjunction with or shortly after the application of insecticides and/or fertilizers.

Media: 2-5 oz./cubic yard of soil.

Drench: 7-10 oz./100 gallons of water or 2 gallons per acre, followed 4-6 weeks later with another application.
