PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Wear protective gloves. Wash thoroughly after handling.

GENERAL INFORMATION

TIMBER is a blend of modified vegetable oil and surfactant that aids in the penetration of herbicides through a plant's waxy cuticle. It may be used in place of crop oil concentrates in spray mixtures. When used as directed, this product maximizes the activity of certain herbicides; therefore, care must be taken when treating sensitive crops during periods when plants are subjected to drought stress, high temperatures and high humidity. This product may be used on agricultural, forestry, turf and ornamental, and non-cropland sites. Not for aquatic use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Always read and follow the entire pesticide label for proper timing, rates, specific directions and any special use precautions or regional use recommendations. Use this product in accordance with the instructions found on the pesticide label regarding adjuvants. In the absence of specific

instructions, follow the recommendations below which are considered adequate for most uses.

MIXING: Shake well before use. Fill spray tank 2/3 full of water and begin agitation. Add tank mix partners as directed by label or in the following sequence and continue filling tank: (1) Dry flowables or water dispersing granules, (2) Wettable powders, (3) Liquid flowables and (4) Emulsifiable concentrates. Add the desired amount of TIMBER last, unless otherwise directed.

Continuous agitation of finished spray is recommended. If spray solution has been allowed to stand, thoroughly remix before application. For best results, apply within 24 hours after mixing.

RATE RECOMMENDATIONS: Optimum use rates can be affected by conditions of application such as water hardness, application method, equipment, spray droplet size, spray nozzle selection, or condition or size of foliage. Therefore, carefully observe spray deposition and adjust adjuvant rate accordingly to ensure thorough coverage without excessive runoff.

Herbicide Application Method	Rate
Ground and aerial	1-2 pints per acre
Backpack and handheld	0.5-6.4 fl oz per gallon of spray mixture

The high end of the recommended use rate may be necessary during periods of extreme stress or weed populations. The addition of a liquid fertilizer (28-32% nitrogen solution) may also be required to improve control under extreme environmental conditions such as drought, high heat, or high humidity.

For pesticides that permit use of an adjuvant at a higher rate, follow instructions on that pesticide label. However, do not add this product at a rate which exceeds 5% of the finished spray volume, except when used as a diluent in dormant, basal, site preparation or other similar applications, per label instructions. Use caution at the higher use rates. When applying to a sensitive crop, first treat a small area to determine if there are any adverse effects to the crop.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Store in original container only and keep tightly sealed when not in use. Store away from incompatible materials. Store above 40°F; do not allow this product to freeze.

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading and add rinsate to spray tank. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal. The Agricultural Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates the national recycling program.
