MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

If the pesticide label does not give instructions use the WALES method: 1) Wettable powders then dry flowables, agitating constantly and allowing each powder to disperse thoroughly before adding the next, 2) Adjuvants such as antifoams and water conditioners but not surfactants, 3) Liquid and soluble products, 4) Emulsifiable concentrates and 5) Surfactants. Add VOYAGER 80/20 as a surfactant last before the final addition of water in the recommended level in the chart above.
