### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**TURFGRASS:** For maintenance of turfgrass, use 10 pounds of **WIL-GRO 8-8-8 ALL PURPOSE PLANT FOOD** per 1,000 sq. ft. or 435 pounds per acre. For repair of damaged turf (such as divot repair, pet damage, traffic wear, insect or disease damage and/or drought stress) use 10 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. or 435 pounds per acre. For preplant, over-seeding, newly seeded or sod establishment, use 12.5 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. or 544 pounds per acre.

**GROUND COVER:** Broadcast at 7.5 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. Repeat every 6-8 weeks throughout the growing season.

**FLOWERS, BULBS AND VEGETABLES:** As a preplant, apply 2.5 pounds per 100 sq. ft. and work into the top 6 inches of soil.

**ROSES (Hybrid Teas or Floribundas):** Use 1 cup per plant.

**CLIMBERS:** Use 2 cups per plant, work into soil.

**SHRUBS (Camellias, Azaleas, Rhododendrons, Gardenias, Junipers, and others):** Use 1-2 cups per plant, depending on size. Distribute evenly over the soil surface beneath the shrub, and scratch lightly into soil.

**TREES (Citrus and Ornamentals):** Use 1-2 cups per 1 inch of trunk diameter. Cultivate into soil surface.

**NOTE:** Liquid measuring cups are very close in estimating the weight of dry granular fertilizers. (Example: An 8-ounce (1 cup) measuring cup holds approximately 8 ounces of dry granular fertilizer.)

For best performance, apply to dry turfgrass and water after application. Do not apply directly to an impervious surface or to ground that is frozen. Sweep or blow off any residual material on adjacent concrete, patios or walkways after application. Keep away from pools, ponds, etc. Do not contaminate potable water.
